5. 7. WHEREAS nothing contained in this deed shall be deemed to authorize the trustees to do any act which may in any way be construed statutory modifications thereof and all activities of the trust shall be carried out with a view to benefit the public at large, without any profit motive and in accordance with the provisions of the Income-Tax Act, 1961 or any statutory modification thereof.

9. AND WHEREAS the trust is hereby expressly declared to be a public charitable trust and ~~all the provisions of this deed~~ are to be constituted accordingly.

NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSTH AS FOLLOWS :

10. NAME:

The name of the Trust shall be "Sanskriti Global Educational Trust".  
The Trust will function as a non-communal and a secular organization.

11. PLACE:

The principal office of the Trust shall be situated at Anand Villa, Budh marg, Patna-01, Bihar or such other place as the Trustee may from time to time decide. The Trust may also carry on its work at any other place or places, as decided by the Trustees.

12. OBJECTS:

The objects for which the Trust is founded are:

- a) To establish, run maintain or assist Institutions for school education, higher education, technical education, management education and other professional education with primary aim to impart high quality education and ensuring continuous improvement of human capital in the country.
- b) To establish, run, maintain the Information Technology Training Institutes and centers for coaching, career guidance, counseling & vocational/ Industrial Training or the youth.
- c) To grant financial aid, scholarships, textbooks, notebooks, uniforms/ cloth, meals to the poor, deserving and needy students

- d) To establish run, maintain or assist medical or Para-medical education Institutes.
- e) To establish run, maintain Libraries, Reading rooms for public use to conduct training classes, seminars for benefit of the community in general.
- f) To establish run, maintain training institutions/ centres; teachers' training institutions and research & training centres for the furtherance of cause of education/ learning in the society.
- g) To acquire and maintain the movable and immovable properties by outright purchase or on lease or on Build-Operate-Lease & Transfer (BOLT) basis for achieving the said objects.
- h) To undertake any other activities incidental to the above activities but which are not inconsistent with the above objects.

13. PRESIDENT :

There shall be a president for the administration of this trust, nominated by the board of Trustees, who shall be one amongst trustees.

14. BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

- i. The management and the control of the Trust and its properties shall vest in the Board of Trustees. The Board of trustees shall comprise of minimum four and Maximum Eleven. The above number shall consist four permanent trustees.

- ii. There shall be two categories of Trustees one "permanent" as mentioned above and "Associate Trustees" Who shall be appointed by the permanent trustees if required for a period of three years.
- ii. Associate Trustees will hold office for a period of three years or for such lesser period as the Board of Trustees may decide from time to time but shall be eligible for reappointment.

15. NUMBER OF TRUSTEES

The number of Trustees including the permanent Trustees shall Not be less than 4(Four) and not more than 11(Eleven) persons. The Board of Trustee shall nominate and invite person/persons to be the other trustees for such period, as they may deem fit and proper.

19. **VACANCIES:**

Any vacancy among the members of the Board of Trustees may be filled by the above named trustee or their successors and they shall hold office for such duration as may be specified by the Board of Trustees.

20. **TERMINATION OF OFFICE OF THE TRUSTEES:**

(a) Trustee shall cease to hold office:

- i) If he dies,
- ii) If he resigns,
- iii) If he is adjudged insolvent or found guilty of an offence involving moral turpitude.
- iv) If he is found to have acted against the interest of the Trust.
- v) If it is unanimously decided by the above named Trustees that his Continuation in the Office is against the interest of the Trust.
- vi) Upon expiry of the period up to which the Board of trustees have nominated the trustee,

21. **POWER OF TRUSTEES:**

That the trustees shall have the following powers :

- (a) To manage all the assets and/or properties of the trust including the conduct of business;
- (b) To appoint employees and to settle the terms of their service, remuneration and termination;
- (c) To look into the management of the trust;
- (d) To invest the funds of the trust, in bank or in the purchase of company shares or securities or other movable and immovable and immovable properties;




- (e) To sell, alter, vary, transpose or otherwise dispose or alienate the trust properties or any investment representing the same for consideration and to reinvest the same;
- (f) To Pledge or mortgage the trust properties for raising loans;
- (g) To open the bank accounts in the name and on behalf of the trust and to operate the same;
- (h) To enter into a partnership on behalf of the trust with any other party or parties;
- (i) To pay all charges, impositions and other outgoings payable in respect of the trust properties and also to pay all cost of the incidental to the administration and management of the trust properties;
- (j) To file suit on behalf of the trust and to refer to arbitration all actions proceedings and disputes Invoicing the trust properties and to compromise and compound the suits filed;
- (k) To accept any gift, donation or contribution in cash or in kind from anyone for the objects of the trust;
- (l) To seek legal opinion of lawyers and/or Chartered accountants as and when required; or to nominate representatives for any of the aforesaid purposes.
- (m) Every trustee will be at liberty to nominate or appoint attorneys or agents and to delegate all or any of the duties and powers vested in him to such attorney or agent, and to remove such attorney or agent and reappoint other or others in his place.
- (n) No trustee shall be responsible or liable for any loss or any act of omission or commission by his constituted attorney or agent or employees or other trustees unless occasioned by his willful neglect or default.

22 MEETING AND PROCEEDINGS OF THE TRUSTEES:

The Trustees shall ordinarily meet once in every three months or as often as may be necessary for the satisfactory conduct of the affairs of the Trust. All the meetings of the Trust shall be called by the Managing Trusty of the Trust.

A. Decisions at a meeting of the trust shall be by a majority of vote.

B. At least seven days previous notice of meeting shall be given to members or ordinary meeting and a day's notice for emergency meeting, provided that in case of urgency, if the Managing Trusty so thinks fit, a resolution can also be passed by circulation.

In case the votes are equal, the Managing Trusty shall have a casting vote.

C. One third (1/3rd) of the Board of Trustees would be the Quorum for any meeting

D. One of the meetings would be called Annual General meeting in which the Audited Statement of Accounts would be presented before the meeting for its approval.

23. NOTICE:


7(seven) days Notice shall ordinarily be given in writing for a meeting of Board of Trustees.

24. QUORUM:

The Quorum for the Meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be 1/3rd of total strength (any fraction contained in that one third being rounded off as one) or three Trustee whichever is higher, out of which two trustees must be permanent trustee. A minute book shall be kept by the Trustee. Minutes of entry into the office of every new trustee and of all proceedings

of the meeting of the board of trustee shall be entered in the minute book and shall be signed by the president of the Meeting.

25. FUNDS:

The Trustees may accept donations, grants, subscriptions, aids or contributions from any person, Government, Local authorities or any other charitable institutions, in cash or in kind including immovable property without any encumbrance, but the Trustees shall not accept any receipt with any condition or terms inconsistent with the objects of the Trusts. While applying such receipts to the objects, the Trustees shall respect the directions, if any, by the granter.

26. INVESTMENTS :

- (a) All Funds, which shall not be immediately required for current needs shall be invested by the Trustees in eligible securities and investments as notified by government of India, or in scheduled banks. Such investments shall be in the name of Trust.
- (b) That the trustees shall invest the trust fund, conduct business with the trust fund and/or enter into partnership on behalf of the trust, as they may deem fit as per objects of the trust.
- (c) That the trustees shall manage the trust fund and investments thereof as a prudent person would do the same. They shall recover all outstanding dues and meet all recurring and other expenses incurred for the upkeep or management thereof.
- (d) That the trustees shall receive and hold the income of the trust on behalf and for the benefit of the beneficiaries of the trust.

27. BOOK ACCOUNT :

29. DEFECTS OF PROCEDURE IMMATERIAL :




30. AMENDMENTS :

32. ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT :

The Trustees shall keep proper books of account of all the assets, liabilities and maintain a true and correct record of the receipts, payments incomes and expenses and transactions of the Trust and shall prepare as Income and expenditure Account and Balance Sheet for every year as on the last day of March. The accounts shall be audited by a Chartered accountant or a firm of Chartered accountants, who shall be appointed for that purpose by the Trustees and the audited accounts shall be placed at a meeting of the Trustees, which shall be held before the end of the succeeding year.

33. IRREVOCABLE :

This Trust is irrevocable.

34. DISSOLUTION/ AMALGAMATION/ WINDING UP :

In the event of dissolution or amalgamation or winding up of the Trust, the assets remaining as on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed amongst the Trustees but the same shall be transferred to some other similar Trust/ Organization, whose objects are similar to those of this Trust with the prior permission of the Charity Commissioner/ Court/ any other law as may be applicable for the time being.






